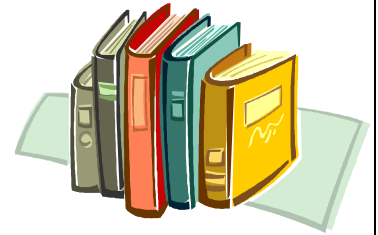

Self-Help Category

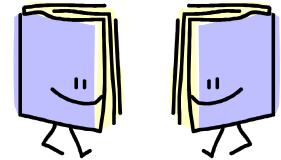
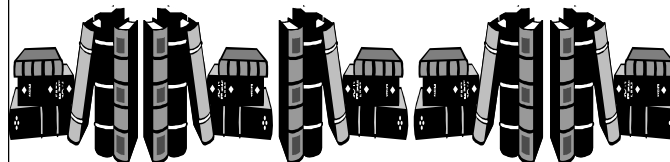
The Self-Help Category includes books about diet, fitness, health, psychology, medicine, diseases, etc. It is important that books in this category are fairly current. Self-Help is a very trendy area, therefore, a book that is popular today may be completely passé in a few years. It doesn't seem wise to clutter the shelves with books no one is interested in purchasing.

Previously, the rule-of-thumb for this category was discarding any books more than five years old. This doesn't seem to be working, as a recent weeding of the Self-Help category produced a tall stack of books more than five years old. Perhaps an easier rule to remember would be to keep only \$2.00 and \$3.00 books. If a Self-Help book prices at \$1.00, it should go to the free shelves.

Therefore, if there isn't room for a new arrival on the Bookstore shelves, simply price it and place it on the appropriate receiving room shelf. Be sure to date books as they are moved into the Bookstore.
