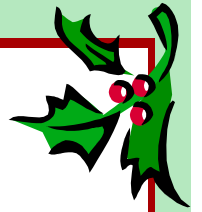
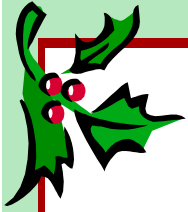
### January Specials
